Carnatic classical music competition conducted in concert format. Each concert will be of 90-minute duration. Applicants can be in the following category: Vocalist, Instrumental Main Artist and Accompanist

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must be over 16 years to 28 years or younger as of December 1st 2017
2. Applicant should have the ability to perform a 90 minute concert
3. Applicant should have performed a few concerts
4. Applicant must get a recommendation letter from the guru certifying the ability to perform a 90 minute concert
5. Applicant can be based in India or abroad
6. Contestants of earlier years who have not been adjudged as winners of Kalavantha are also eligible.

Key Dates

1. Last date to submit application is 15th June 2017
2. Applicants will receive confirmation in October 2017
3. Kalavanta will in January 2018
